- Drs. Fritz Deininger and Paul Sanders recently completed an **IPAL seminar** in Abidjan in March. It was organized by FATEAC, co-sponsored by CITAF and ICETE. 18 academic leaders from 5 Francophone nations attended, and were so encouraged that they requested and have already begun planning for a second seminar in early 2017.

- An academic-practical international conference entitled “The Reformation: East European Dimensions” took place 13-15 April 2016. The event was initiated by the **Slavic**



Research and Resource Center of the Euro-Asian Accrediting Association (E-AAA)

and organized as part of a larger program commemorating the upcoming 500th anniversary of the Protestant Reformation. A total of nearly ninety scholars took part in the
